

Design: "Car" *Has 12 color stops instead of 11. A few PDF files were incorrect & only showed 11 colors. Below are the correct directions for the car.**

Stitches 10872 Size: 169mm x 79mm



- Color #1 Black thread on Sulky® Soft' n Sheer™ stabilizer. **STOP** After #1 is complete, lay the cut shape over the placement line.
- Color #2 Tackdown stitch to attach the tag to the stabilizer. **STOP** (either remove fabric inside round hang hole or use eyelet pliers when design is complete.)
- **Before beginning color #3**, lay a piece of **solid appliqué fabric** over the tag. Stitch color #3 to tack down the center appliqué patch. **STOP** When color #3 is complete, trim the appliqué patch close to the stitching lines.
- Color #4 Appliqué patch satin stitch
- ***Color #5 This is a placement line for the two windows. Just embroider color five with blue thread.***
- Color #6 **Before beginning color #6**, **STOP** and lay a piece of blue appliqué fabric over the tag for the window appliqué. Stitch color #6 to tack down the windows appliqué shapes. **STOP** When color #6 is complete, trim the appliqué close to the stitching lines making sure to trim between each window.
- Color #7 Appliqué window satin stitch. **STOP** After #7 is complete, spray a large piece of fabric with adhesive & lay underneath the hoop with the right side of the fabric facing the feed teeth (this will cover the back of the tag with fabric).
- Color #8 Tackdown to attach the fabric to the back of the tag. **After #8 is complete**, remove the hoop from the embroidery arm, turn the hoop over to the wrong side, & trim the fabric close to the stitching line. **If you are cutting out the hang holes, then use an Exacto knife to trim the fabric inside the round hole.**
- **⊗⊗⊗**Color #9 (***)**Use 30-weight embroidery thread in the needle & matching 40-weight in the bobbin.**) Outside perimeter of the tag. This will first stitch zigzag underlay stitches & then go into the final satin stitch border. HINT: Before the final satin stitch border starts, make sure that the zigzag stitches are completely covering the tag. If you have excess fabric beyond the zigzag stitches, then trim a bit more fabric before the final satin stitch begins (see image under "Badge").
- **⊗⊗⊗**Color #10 Black tires
- **⊗⊗⊗**Color #11 Silver metallic rims ~switch to a metallic needle & reduce the embroidery speed to the slowest setting (use grey or black thread in bobbin)
- **⊗⊗⊗**Color #12 round hang hole

“Heart & Heart2” ~ Color # 5 directions were incorrect on a few PDF files. Below is the correct direction for color step 5 on both hearts.



- Color #5 *Before color #5, **STOP** spray a large piece of fabric with adhesive & lay underneath the hoop with the right side of the fabric facing the feed teeth (this will cover the back of the tag with fabric.)*
